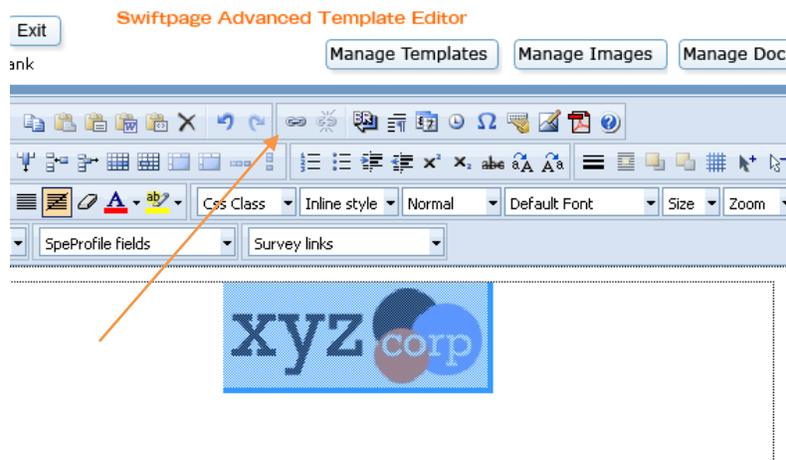

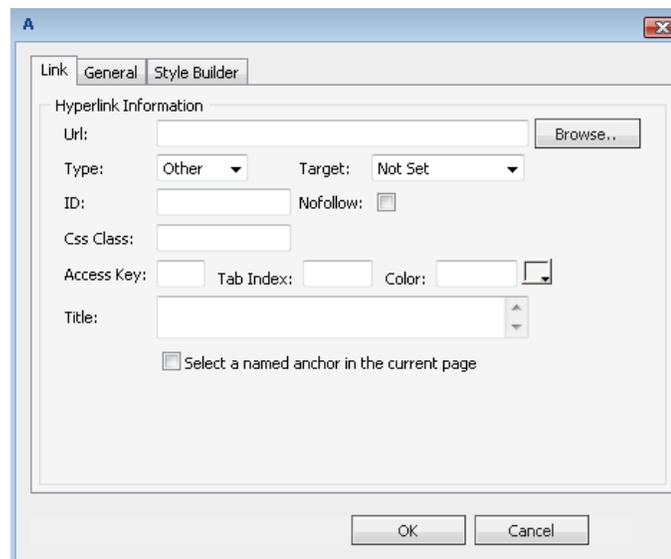
Quick Start Guide To:

Linking Images to the Web in Advanced Editor

- First see the Quick Start Guide To: Images in Advanced Editor
- In the Advanced Template Editor, highlight the image you wish to hyperlink.



- In the toolbar at the top, click on the chain-link icon. You will see the following link menu:



- Select the drop-down menu next to Type: and change it to http://. Then in the URL field, type in the website address you would like to link to.
