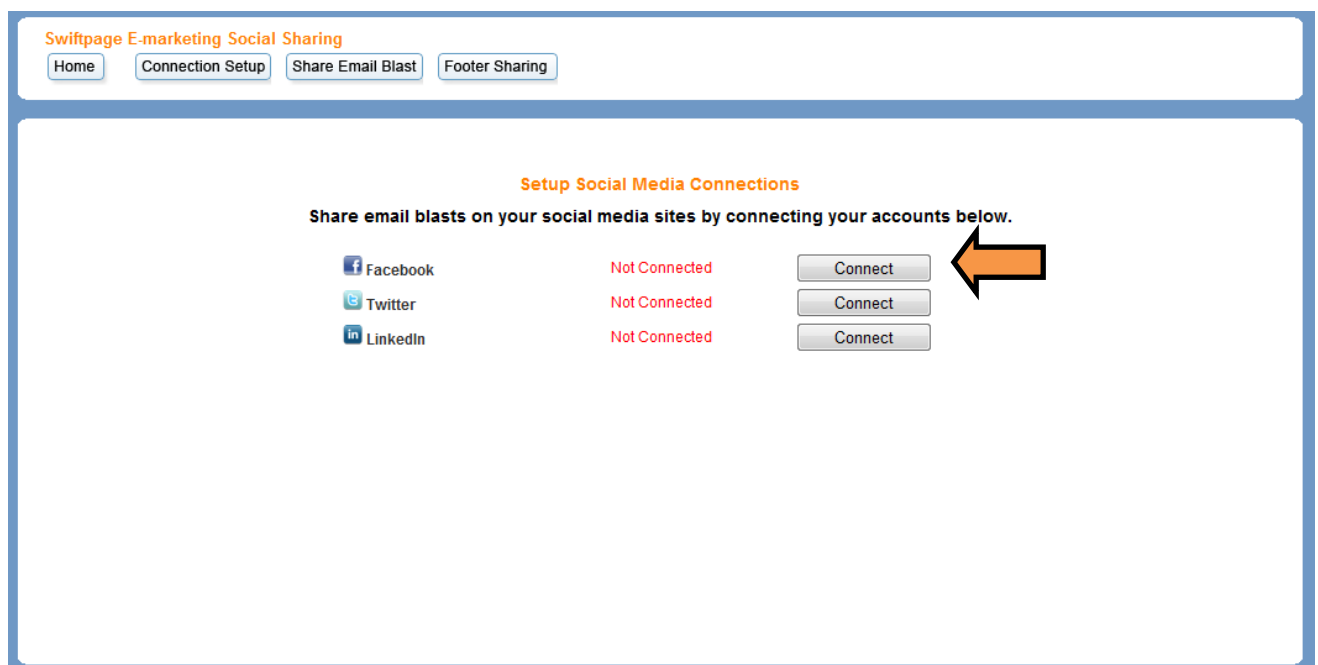
Swiftpage Social Sharing – Connecting to a Facebook Business Page

This Quick Start Guide will guide you through connecting Swiftpage to a Facebook business page.

1. Go to www.Swiftpage.com.
2. Input your account details at the top of the screen and click on Submit.
3. Once you are at the Home screen, click on Social Sharing.



4. Swiftpage Social Sharing will then open to the Connection Setup page. Click the Connect button which corresponds with Facebook.



5. If you are not already logged in to Facebook, enter your Facebook account details and click Log In.

6. Click Allow to grant the Swiftpage Social Sharing application access to your Facebook account.
